

## What qualifications do I need to be a Tutor and how ?

It is not necessary to be a teacher to be a tutor. Our volunteers range from Sophomores in High School to Adults. Each tutor is given an orientation at Dock Village and given guided supervision by a certified teacher. So, if you enjoy children and desire to have a positive impact on their

lives you may already be qualified! After an initial meeting to discuss the program, its goals and answer

any questions, you will receive the volunteer application to complete. Applications ask where your own strengths in varying subjects are, along with references. Each application will then be reviewed by the Academic Supports Coordinator. After acceptance, you will be matched with your student to tutor!

The Tutoring Program was established in 2001 to address the academic needs of our community's children through a one-on-one mentoring type relationship with volunteer tutors.



Our community room provides a safe environment for tutoring to take place with computer accessibility.

The program is offered free of charge for all participants who reside at Dock Village.

Tutoring is open to children in Kindergarten through ninth grade who live in the Dock Village Community and attend North Penn School District schools, and private schools in the local area.

Tutoring is an extremely rewarding opportunity! You can become an integral part of a student's life! In the center's quiet and safe environment, you may open the door for your student's future by motivating him or her to strive for academic and career success in the future!

## TUTORING

**T**he primary goals for the Tutoring Program are to have a strong, positive academic impact, model the value of education, and help to establish an affirming student / student relationship.

Our Tutoring Program works closely with local schools giving the most individualized instructions for each student. We have resources including: curriculum, books, math manipulatives, and educational board and computer games.

Additionally, Dock Village also provides non-required opportunities for you to attend seasonal events with your student that enhance relationship building.

### Tutors Job Description

- Arrive early for your scheduled time with a smile and positive attitude that encourages an atmosphere that learning can be fun for the student!
- Provide DV Child with snack (provided by DV).
- Provide one on one tutoring with educational tools/ aides as specified by child's parent, or Academic Supports Coordinator.
- Assist Dock Village children (ages k-9th) in completing homework assignments, reports, and projects.
- Be a presence and provide assistance when needed to your DV student when using the computer lab for educational purposes.
- Identify any additional needs of your student to the Academic Supports Coordinator.
